Financial Aid Definition

Ideal youth

- Member, 1 year or greater, Peppermint Ponies 4H Club
- Enrolled and active in Horse Apprentice Program (HAP), or similar community service activity.
- Regularly attends 4H Club meetings and activities
- Has chosen horseback riding as a favorite sport. Will give up other activities for riding.
- Has adult support for horse activities and transportation
- Will create Individual Project for exhibit at Stratham and Deefield Fairs
- Will actively participate in club fund raising events

Youth Question:

What is your intent for the financial aid? Who, what will benefit from the money? Why does this recipient deserve the aid?

Parent Question:

Are you available to support your youth's interest in horses? Can you provide the time and schedule necessary? Why should your child deserve this scholarship aid?

Financial Aid

- Four financial aid funds will be offered per year at \$250 each.
- Youth may apply for aid annually.
- Youth may apply for additional aid as needed.

Financial Aid can be applied to pay for:

Activities/events associated with Peppermint Ponies and/or North Road Farm. Funds can also be used for activities/events not associated with and independent of Peppermint Ponies Farm and/or North Road.

- Summer camp
- Horseback riding
- Membership, books
- Horse show/event
- Field Trip
- Academic/tuition
- Charitable donations

Application Process

Financial Aid application is on an open rolling basis. For priority consideration apply by February 1. For County/State and/or Circuit Horse Shows apply by March 15
